Behold, I am doing a new thing; now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?

Happy New Year! Well, New Year's Resolution Season is officially in full effect. I think it's interesting that most of these resolutions typically end with some sort of self-improvement plan: reading more and watching to less, eating less junk food to improve our health, getting out of debt, flossing daily. But these resolutions usually begin with a dubious set of questions: What is wrong with me? Am I too fat or too skinny, too lazy or do I work too much, too much of the tight-wad or too much of a spendthrift, too quiet or too loud, too angry or too much of a doormat, worry too much, don't care enough. Certainly something is wrong with me?!

But, crazy thought here, what if instead of asking what is wrong with me and how can I fix myself, we asked a different kind of question. What if we asked: *How can I fit into what God is doing in me and in the world?* This is the kind of question that redirects our perspective and energies. We begin to move from self-centered to God-centered (which will inevitably move toward other-centered service). We stop scrutinizing what is wrong with us and begin looking at what gifts God has given us. We slow down and pay attention. What "new thing" is God doing in you?

Snow Schedule for Worship

Update from the board:

At a recent board meeting, the board approved a contract extension for Pastor Greg. His contract, at 50% time, has been extended until the end of March. The board also formed a calling team to provide a focus for anchor ministry discussed in the October Dunker. The board appointed Dale Delauter, Pam Jouannet, Robert Riggs, Fred Rudman, and Holly Thomasson to be on the committee and initially focus on pulpit supply. ENGAGING THE QUERY
